



# JUST ASKING - JUST SAYING

A lot of homeowners are asking what the future looks like here in Bayside Village?

I'm not Nostradamus, but having lived here for over 20 years, I can provide an educated guess of what our future holds. A lot of us are trying to decide what we should do, knowing that our community will be facing three new events in the next three years.

- 1. The start of construction of the Sanitation District Pump Station, the new Seawall, and the Marina Expansion Project.
- 2. Long-term leases expiring in 2026.
- 3. Finally, Back Bay Landing project, with potential public access on the marina walkway, remodeling of the garage storage units, potential compromise of our private beach, and the issues that come along with increased road and foot traffic.

Considering these challenges, here is what I know and what I think:

I know the City has approved the pump station, so we must rely on the City to oversee this construction. Since we are the most affected neighbors, we must diligently report any violations to our HOA so our HOA can report these to the City. The City has yet to approve the Seawall Project and Marina Expansion, however, once this project is fully understood and is subject to public hearings, your HOA will diligently engage where needed to try to ensure these projects do not interfere with the residents of Bayside Village. Due to the Pump Station project, the Back Bay Landing project will be completely redesigned, and our community, through the HOA, will be in a much better position to influence a positive outcome for us all.

With many long-term leases expiring in December 2026, management will be required to offer to all homeowners the then-current lease options that are being offered. As an example, this would be the annual leases currently offered to all residents whose leases have expired over the past few years. We do not know if there will be longer-term leases offered in 2026/2027, but we do know that we are entitled to participate in whatever is ultimately being offered at that time.

I think the Pump Station, like all development projects, will undergo several ecological and engineering setbacks, which will, in all probability, extend the life of this development from the projected 2029 completion date to something further out. I need help speculating on the Seawall and Marina Expansion Project, but I hope this significant disturbance to the Ecological Reserve and the Homeowners of Bayside Village will be seriously considered. Your HOA will present our concerns to the Developer, the City, and the California Coastal Commission. The Back Bay Landing is a mystery, but they may still try to force public access and beach alteration to retain their residential component.

Our quiet little Bayside community will be challenged. However, our new HOA will be better positioned to influence these negative construction issues and work to protect our boundaries from public access and beach encroachment. Join the HOA now to ensure your future! You keep asking, and I'll keep saying...

# MARY LEWIS' FAMOUS CINCO CHILE CHEESE SQUARES

If you were not fortunate enough to sneak a bite of these delicious squares at the fiesta, here's a chance to make this easy recipe at home!

### Ingredients:

1 stick butter or margarine

10 eggs, slightly beaten

1/2 cup all-purpose flour

1 tsp baking powder

1/2 tsp of salt

1 cup chopped green chiles (canned is ok)

1 pt small curd cottage cheese (2 cups)

8 oz shredded cheddar cheese

8 oz shredded Monterey Jack cheese

#### Instructions:

Melt butter and cool.

Pour into large bowl, add eggs, beating slightly.

Add in all other ingredients and mix well.

Pour into a buttered 13" x 9 x 2" pan.

Bake at 400 degrees for 15 minutes - THEN lower to 350 degrees and finish baking for 30 more minutes.




