

## JUST ASKING - JUST SAYING

Dear HOA Members,

I hope you've had a chance to read my articles on public access in the July and August Seabreeze. If not, you can find them on byhoa.org for more background.

The Public Access Problem: This issue is complex and affects all of us, not just waterfront homeowners. Many non-HOA members are unaware of the problem, and some HOA members think it only concerns the waterfront. However, the California Coastal Commission (CCC) and the Developer are not addressing our concerns, and the City of Newport Beach is not fully aware of the potential negative impacts on Bayside Village. Our community's unique location, with its single entrance, narrow streets, and limited parking, allows us to enjoy seclusion. If public access is permitted, we could face issues similar to those on Balboa Island and Newport Peninsula, such as increased traffic, crime, vandalism, vagrancy, and homelessness.

#### Possible Solutions:

- Rental Housing: While rental housing has been a partial solution for Balboa Island and the Peninsula, it brings added traffic, noise, and parking problems. This is not a practical solution for Bayside Village due to MRL regulations and the potential to disrupt our village environment.
- City Involvement: We need the City of Newport Beach to take an active role in addressing
  this issue. The City has the responsibility to protect our rights and can conduct a thorough
  investigation into the practicality and legality of committing the Marina Walkway to public
  access. The CCC's Coastal Act, Section 30212(a)(2), states that public access is required in
  new developments except where adequate access already exists. The Back Bay already has
  extensive public access, making additional access unnecessary. The City can help influence
  the CCC's decisions and protect our community.

Our BVHOA, through the BIC, is dedicated to keeping Bayside Village safe from uncontrolled public access. Please join the HOA and be ready to support our efforts with the City. Together, we can protect our community.

























- 1 dozen snack size flour tortillas
- 2 dozen slices boiled ham
- 1 dozen canned whole green chilis (split and cleaned)
- 1 dozen 1 inch slices jack cheese

#### Instructions:

Roll 2 slices ham and one chile in tortilla Wrap with jack cheese slice Place in 2 buttered 13 x 9 pans, seam side down (Can be covered and refrigerated at this point)

#### Mix together:

- 4 cups medium white sauce
- 1/2 tsp dry mustard
- 2 shakes cayenne pepper
- 1 shake paprika
- 1 grated cheddar cheese

Pour sauce over tortilla rolls

Top with some grated cheese and paprika saved from above

Bake 20-30 minutes at 350 degrees until brown on top Nice with cranberry and orange salad or fruit salad!





#### A Tribute to Burnham Kimball Drake

"Drako" 4/25/1933-8/2/2024 303 Lexington Circle

(He enjoyed 3 different residences here in Bayside Village over the past 6 years)

My father, "Drako," was more than just a man; he was a legend, a force of nature, Larger than Life and my everything. He lived life with a passion that few could match. His love for animals was as vast as the ocean he adored. At one point, he had up to 13 rescue dogs, each one a testament to his boundless compassion and care. He found his peace lifting weights at Venice Beach, where the sun kissed his skin and the waves carried him as he body surfed, reveling in the joy of the moment.

Born in Hollywood, his life was anything but ordinary. He spent his childhood in Laguna Beach, where he formed an incredible bond with his mother. The sun-soaked shores of Laguna became the backdrop for their deep connection, a place where they lived and created memories that would shape the man he became. His love for the ocean and the beach was born there, nurtured by his mother's presence and the beauty of the coastline.

He later served our country with honor in the Korean War as part of the UDT, the precursor to the Navy SEALs, embodying strength, bravery, and dedication. After his service, he channeled that same strength into bodybuilding, becoming an avid bodybuilder and wrestler who believed in pushing his limits and maintaining peak physical health. The gym and the beach were his sanctuaries, where he sculpted his body and mind with determination and discipline.

But his talents didn't stop there. My father "Drako" was a master of his craft, a specialty painting contractor whose work was in a class of its own. He took on some of the most prestigious projects, including the Western White House and homes of famous Hollywood figures. His eye for detail and commitment to excellence made his work stand out, earning him a reputation that few could rival.

Motorcycles roared beneath him as he embraced the thrill of the ride, always seeking the next adventure. He believed in living life to the fullest, and every day was an opportunity to push himself, whether in the gym, on the beach, or in his work. He cherished every moment, living with a vitality that inspired everyone around him. He was a master storyteller!

But more than anything, we were each other's everything. His love, guidance, and the bond we shared are treasures that I will carry with me forever. He was my hero, my confidant, my legend. The world is a little less bright without Drako, but his spirit will always be with me—in the ocean waves, the warmth of the sun, and the endless memories of a life lived to its fullest.

Even in his later years, my father was unbelievably good-looking, with muscles that rippled with strength and a full head of hair that stayed with him right up until the end. His physical presence was as impressive as his spirit was indomitable. I was there, holding his hand right up until his last moment, when he peacefully went to heaven, leaving behind a legacy of love, strength, and unforgettable memories.... He always told me he loved me and was proud of me ...

I miss you so much Dad


